Clonenagh National School News

Clonenagh National School, Mountrath are collecting unwanted clothes, paired shoes, hats, hand-bags, bags, scarves, belts, hats, soft toys and scarves as a fundraiser for the school. The collection is part of the Bags2School Ireland Scheme, which exports reusable items of suitable quality to developing countries, and at the same time, provides funds to the school, linked directly to the weight collected. As an additional bonus, LauraLynn, Ireland's Children's Hospice will also receive an additional 10% from Bag2School on top of the value raised by the school.
